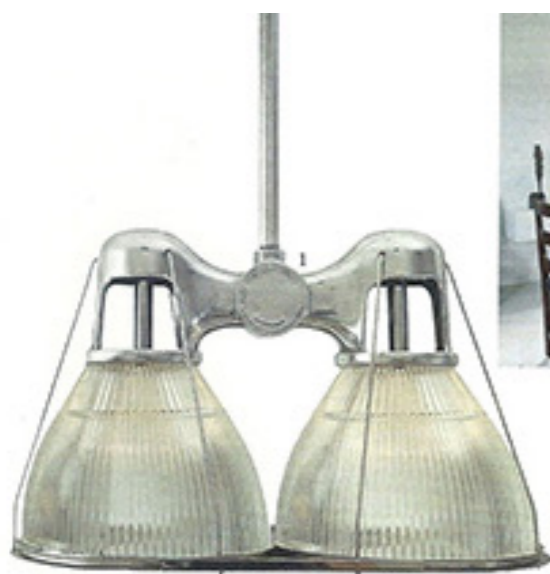

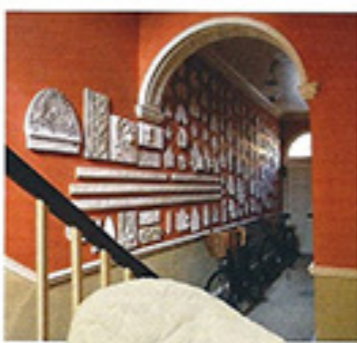

3 Florence Lopez's dining-room fresco (page 282) is a homage to the Bauhaus. It's also on trend for the autumn: Cole & Son's new 'Geometric' collection has 15 optical designs, including 'Facet' (£189 per 3 x 1.8m panel, in blue and grey colourways), a wallpaper rather like Florence's fresco. 4 The Jean Prouvé/Charlotte Perriand bed in Florence Lopez's flat (page 287) is pared-down and elegant. So too is this 'Lit Flavigny' bed, one of 17 'Prouvé Raw' pieces developed in a collaboration between Vitra, G-Star and the Prouvé family. The original was designed by Jean Prouvé in 1945, but the new version costs a thoroughly modern £3,290. Ring 020 7608 6200, or visit vitra.com.

5 Peter Malone fashioned the ghostly grove of plaster leaves that hang in his entrance hall (page 310). For ready-made foliage, Peter Hone forages in his own garden for 'the best leaf shapes, all individual and one-off' and renders them in plaster form with beautiful intricacy. From £25. 6 The Pas-de-Calais installations show unimagined possibilities for the humble pallet as towers, staircases, even a bench (page 274). We present another, more practical use, as a table.
